



**who is celebrating Mass here at All Saints Parish this weekend. Fr. Crucis will speak about the Orphanage of the Virgin of Guadalupe (OVG) which he founded in the Philippines.**

“Up on the streets of the metropolitan Manila and down in the local provinces, unwanted children, neglected, abused (including those in child labor), scavengers, homeless and the orphaned are a common sight. The Orphanage of the Virgin of Guadalupe houses less fortunate children like these in three modest houses which stand in a 3-acre property. These houses, which were built by SMAHE personnel (to save money), are a place of love, trust, mutual interest and unselfish service, i.e. a place of harmony and contentment. Although incomplete, these houses have become a home. Since founding, in 1990, the orphanage has graduated, i.e., returned to the population, 463 healthy, happy, educated orphans who have a good start on life.”
