



who is celebrating Mass here at All Saints Parish this weekend. Fr. Crucis will speak about the Orphanage of the Virgin of Guadalupe (OVG) which he founded in the Philippines.

"Up on the streets of the metropolitan Manila and down in the local provinces, unwanted children, neglected, abused (including those in child labor), scavengers, homeless and the orphaned are a common sight. The Orphanage of the Virgin of Guadalupe houses less fortunate children like these in three modest houses which stand in a 3-acre property. These houses, which were built by SMAHE personnel (to save money), are a place of love, trust, mutual interest and unselfish service, i.e. a place of harmony and contentment. Although incomplete, these houses have become a home. Since founding, in 1990, the orphanage has graduated, i.e., returned to the population, 463 healthy, happy, educated orphans who have a good start on life."
