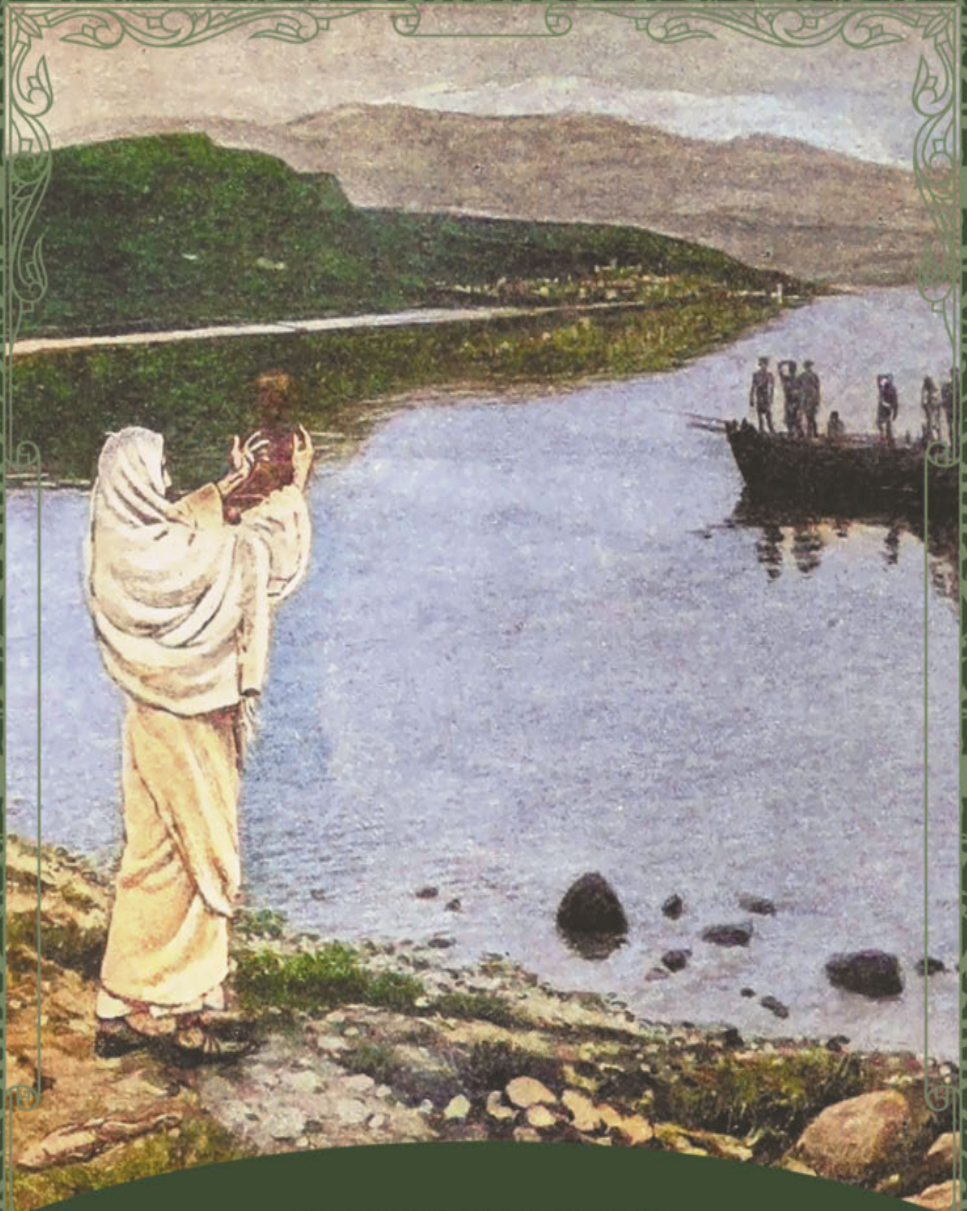

### **2025 Baby Bottle Fundraiser**

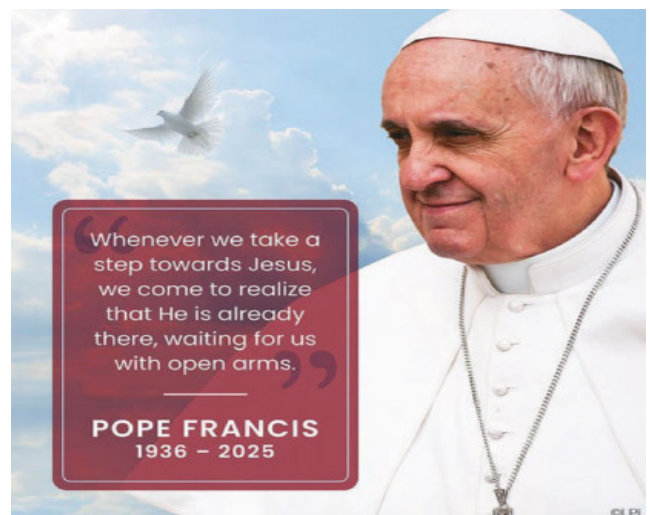
The Knights of Columbus in Erie and Crawford Counties are conducting our 4th annual Baby Bottle Fundraiser. Your charitable donations thus far have enabled the Knights to purchase five state of the art Ultrasound Machines and a Mobile Ultrasound Clinic for the Women's Care Center of Erie. Since 2018, 702 babies have been born to women after they viewed their ultrasounds. They chose life for their children, even though they were originally abortion bound.

The Women's Care Center continues to face a financial crisis due to a large cut in funding by the state of PA that began last year. They actively promote childbirth as an option, rather than abortion by providing pregnancy, parenting, and adoption support services.

In order to keep providing these vital services, the Women's Care Center depends on our financial support. Baby bottles and/or envelopes will be distributed at the church entrance on Mother's Day weekend (May 10-11th). Please take one home and fill it with spare change, cash, or checks. Envelopes will also be available as an option to the Baby Bottles. The bottles and envelopes should be returned by the weekend of June 21 & 22.
