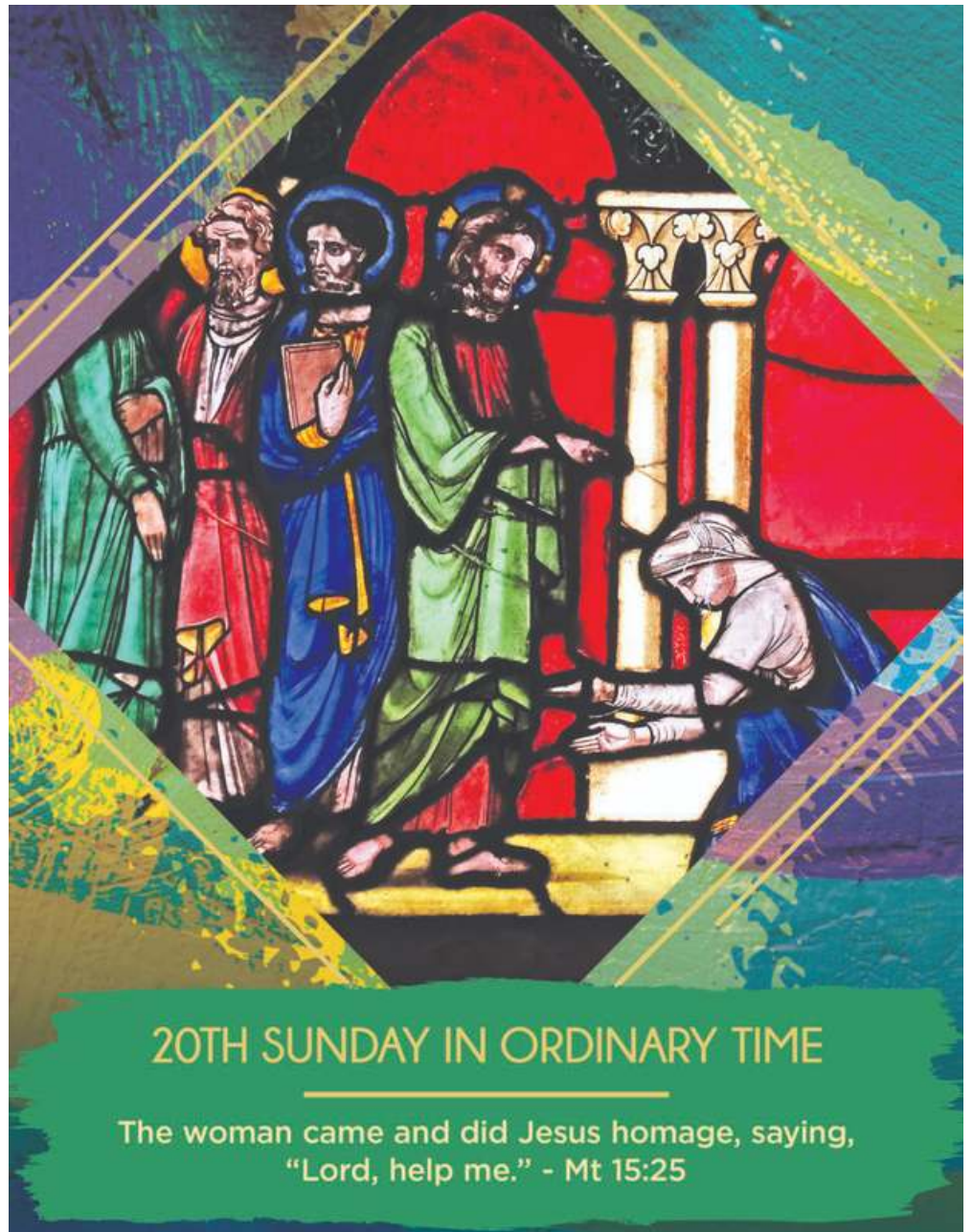

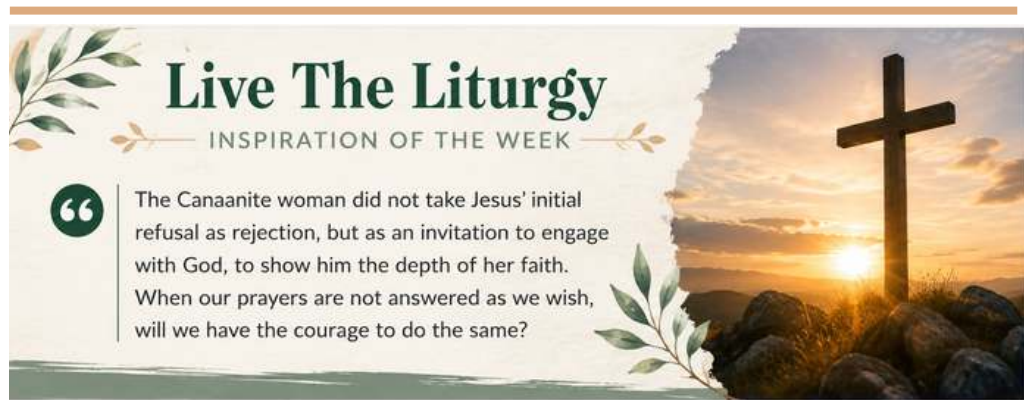

# St. Bernard *of Clairvaux*

AUGUST 20

St. Bernard of Clairvaux was born in 1090 into a noble family in France. At the age of 22, he left behind wealth and comfort to follow Christ more closely, joining the Cistercian monks at Clairvaux.

A man of deep prayer and great learning, he became a brilliant teacher and preacher. His words inspired many to return to God and live with sincerity, humility, and love.

He founded many monasteries, guided popes and kings with wisdom, and worked for peace in the Church. Above all, he had a great love for Jesus and Mary, and his teachings continue to draw hearts closer to Christ.

He died on August 20, 1153.

## 06 • PRAYER & MEDITATION



### *Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture*

A Canaanite woman calls out, "Have pity on me, Lord, Son of David!" At first, he is silent. Then he rebuffs her.

**"It is not right to take the food of the children and throw it to the dogs."** But the Church Fathers saw this not as an insult but as an initiation. Christ draws out of her heart a deeper faith.

She presses on. **"Please, Lord, even the dogs eat the scraps that fall from the table of their masters."** Jesus' silence and response solidify her humility and trust. She thus becomes a model for prayer for centuries of Christians.

This woman is the Church. She is you and me. She is every soul who dares to cry out from the margins, who endures divine silence until it turns to compassion. When Jesus says, **"O woman, great is your faith,"** it is the joyful cry of God discovering faith where the world least expects it.
